- d) JAVELIN LUNG: Phase 3 open label multicenter trial of Avelumab (MSB0010718C) vs platinum based doublet as first line treatment of recurrent or stage IV PDL1+ non-small cell lung cancer.
- e) AR-V7 splice variant in Asian patients with metastatic castration resistant prostate cancer. (IIT)
- f) Phase Ib/II multicenter, open label, randomised study of BI836845 in combination with Enzalutamide versus Enzalutamide alone in metastatic castration-resistant prostate cancer following disease progression on Docetaxel-based chemotherapy.
