Yeul Hong Kim, MD, PhD is Professor of Medical Oncology at the Korea University College of Medicine as well as Director of the Korea University Cancer Institute. He is certified in internal medicine and medical oncology by the Korean Association of Internal Medicine.

Dr. Kim is primarily interested in the chemotherapy of stomach cancer, colon cancer and other gastrointestinal cancers including pancreatic cancer and biliary cancer. He is actively involved in the Cancer Genomic research for lung and gastrointestinal cancers using microarray, proteomics, and NGS analysis. He is a pioneer in Korea in the area of liquid biopsy using circulating tumor DNA isolated from cancer patient's blood. He currently is the Chairman of Board, the Korean Cancer Association and President of Asian Clinical Oncology Society. Currently he is Director of the K-MASTER Cancer Precision Medicine Diagnosis and Treatment Enterprise, which is funded from Korea Ministry of Health and Welfare. He has published 174 papers in SCI or SCIE listed peer-reviewed medical journals including Nature Genetics, Lancet, Journal of Clinical Oncology, Clinical Cancer Research, etc..

He graduated from the Korea University Medical College and received a PhD degree in the Korea University, Seoul Korea. He was a rotating intern and resident at the Korea University Hospital. He was a research fellow in the Department of Gastrointestinal Medical Oncology and Thoracic/Head and Neck Medical Oncology of the MD Anderson Cancer Center, Houston, Texas, USA.
